Max.29°/Av.15°/700m
This bumpy course is ideal for mogul skiers.

Speise Course
Max.32°/Av.15°/3,300m
An exciting long run.
You can enjoy night ski as well.

Ladies' Downhill Course
Max.32°/Av.14°/2,410m
Enjoy breathtaking views of Mt. Tokachi-Dake and Tassetsuzan Mountains.

Giant Course
Max.32°/Av.19°/700m
Suitable for advanced skiers and snowboarders and offers good practice for intermediates.

Todomatsu Course
Max.25°/Av.11°/700m
Try the run with the poles set by Kiminobu Kimura, the 4-time Olympic success from mid. Jan to early Mar.

Prince Course
Max.18°/Av.8°/900m
This wide course is ideal for beginners and snowboarding lessons.

Kitanomine Zone
Kitanomine Zone season:
the beginning of Dec.~the end of Mar.
